- Assist in the planning of site work and the preparation of risk assessments and method statements.
- Ensure all equipment; consumables required for the job are ready and are in good working order for the start of the job. Also ensure that technicians have the right certifications and experience to do the work.
- Communicate instructions to colleagues to complete tasks and use resources in a cost effective and efficient manner to achieve targeted profitability on the job.
- To use resources effectively and profitably with the aim of achieving targets set whilst satisfying the needs of the customer.

- Prepare equipment for use and ensure instruments used are calibrated.
- Ensure van is equipped, clean and serviced according to manufacturer's guidelines.
- Ensure own, and others, health and safety and that technicians are fully trained on all aspects relating to their role.
- Review and make recommendations for new methods and techniques with Team Manager, sharing knowledge and experience.
- Be part of our weekly 24/7 'on-call' rota on a pro rata basis.
